**Guidelines**

- The contest is open to any students who are currently enrolled in WRT 101 or who were enrolled in WRT 101 at Pima Community College during the 2017/2018 Academic Year.
- Students must limit submissions to one category (Essay #1, Essay #2, and/or Essay #3).
- Entries must align with the WRT 101 OER Essay prompts. Students can contact their English instructors for the writing prompts.
- Awards will be given to the top three essays in each category: • First Place: \$75 • Second Place: \$50 • Third Place: \$35
- Award funds will be disbursed to students' accounts.
- Winners must agree to offer their essays as examples in English courses and must sign waivers to verify their approval.
- The contest window will extend from March 10 through April 10, 2018.
